

Anti Doping Statement

The United Kingdom Cheerleading Association (UKCA) fully agrees with the UK Anti-Doping and World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) position that cheating (including doping) in sport is fundamentally contrary to the spirit of all sport.

Doping corrodes trust and teamwork and undermines the spirit of fair play. It is entirely contrary to UKCA's principles of competitive equality, fairness and inclusiveness, and it has the potential to diminish the otherwise positive impact of Cheerleading across all sections of society.

As a member of the International Federation of Cheerleading (IFC), UKCA commits to adhere to the spirit and rules of the 'IFC Anti Doping Rules 2015' document. UKCA will continue to promote anti doping measures across all of its activity as an organisation, and will continue to work closely with the IFC and other relevant bodies to further this cause.
